## Exciting Plans for 2022

With the first month of 2022 behind us, Southport is looking forward to the many exciting things to come in the year ahead.

This spring, Southport will break ground for two new duplexes in the Centenaire South residential development, bringing the total number of duplexes in the neighbourhood to 10. Southport's five year furnace upgrade program will continue with a number of the 188 residential units receiving new electric furnaces. Southport's residential upgrade program will continue with 16 units receiving interior and exterior upgrades. Southport's annual Yard Beautification Contest will be held throughout the summer months, with a grand prize winner selected in August.

Many Climate Smart initiatives will take place in 2022-23 including the acquisition of Southport's first electric pickup truck, installation of eight electric vehicle charging stations around the site, and two more employees will become certified through the Climate Smart training program. Training and professional development opportunities will continue to be sought and offered to staff.

Southport's Facilities team will be working on improving our recreation facility, Central Plains RecPlex, with a new AC unit in the gymnasium.

Following a successful 2021 season, the Southport Golf Club is set to open in the springtime for the 2022 golf season.

An event celebrating the important milestone of Southport's 30th Anniversary will take place in the Interpretive Park along with a surprise unveiling.

## Early Southport Mornings

Early mornings make for great photos featuring Southport's gate guard, a CT-114 Tutor that proudly greets visitors and guards the community. The Tutor was used to train pilots at CFB Portage la Prairie (now Southport) and represents a legacy of more than 75 years of military flight training at Southport.

The aircraft was officially revealed as Southport's gate guard on April 29, 2017, in celebration of Southport's 25th anniversary and the 50th anniversary of the Golden Centennaires' flying demonstration team. This flight team was assembled in 1967 for Canada's Centennial Celebrations. The team called Southport home from September 1, 1966 until their disbandment on January 12, 1968. During this time they performed 103 shows in Canada.

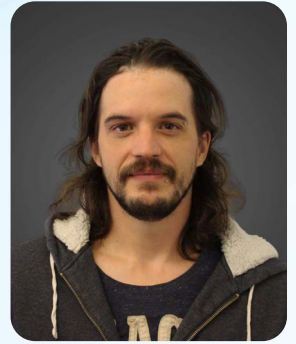
